THRESHOLD THEATER ANNOUNCES PARTNERSHIP WITH THE BLACK HART OF ST. PAUL FOR STAGED READING SERIES AND COMING OUT CABARET FUNDRAISER

MINNEAPOLIS, MN (February 15, 2022) —Threshold Theater announces its partnership with The Black Hart of St. Paul to present four in-person staged readings of plays that exemplify Threshold Theater’s mission to “produce fresh LGBTQ+ works”.

The Black Hart opened August 2018 in the space of the old Town House Bar. Located a thousand feet from the new Allianz Field, the Black Hart is the new spiritual home for soccer in the Twin Cities, a place to catch matches from around the world of soccer. The Black Hart continues the long legacy of Town House Bar as a home for the LGBTQ+ community.

The four-part reading series will kick off on March 26, 2022 with Bonnie Antosh’s “Lemuria,” an inheritance drama about dominance, queer Southern scientists, academic lineage, sex, and – yes – lemurs. Threshold Theater’s 2nd Annual Coming Out Cabaret fundraiser will be held in October to support the theater.
