ABOUT THE PLAY:

After her husband Lee dies suddenly, neuroscientist Renee uses her consciousness-transferal technology, with the assistance of her lab tech Greg, to inhabit Lee's body and secure the future of her company. Renee believes Lee's schedule is full of board meetings and investor schmoozing. Instead, she meets a sex worker named Alma he's been wooing, has a disconcerting interaction with Lee's best friend Helen, and is struck by her own new and confusing feelings of desire. Not to mention the hallucinations... or are they memories? When the hallucinations begin, Renee needs to believe they're minor flaws in her otherwise revolutionary technology. But when she starts "remembering" things she never witnessed and conversing with Lee's ghost, she suspects something far more frightening is at play.

ABOUT THE PLAYWRIGHT:

Allison Moon is the author of five books including the instant classic sex-ed guide "Girl Sex 101." Inspired by her sex education work, Moon writes screenplays, stage plays, and teleplays that explore the complexities of identity, sexuality and desire, particularly when interfacing with technology. Her newest play "Zero State" was an O'Neill Semifinalist (2022). She has a degree in Neuroscience and Theatre from Oberlin College and is an MFA candidate in Creative Writing for the Performing Arts at UC Riverside ('24).
